CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert N. Caldwell, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rock Spring through a spring, spring box, distribution system and stockwatering trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Lot 1 of Section 19, T.37N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M., (Unsurveyed) or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 6, T.36N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 0° 53' W., 14,974 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Delong Ranches, Inc.
Source: Rock Spring
Manner of Use: stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.0124 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 8, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place or use:

Water is diverted from Rock Spring into a spring box consisting of a cement cave 3' x 8", thence via 300' of 1 1/4" plastic pipe to a 300 gallon missile tank trough where 400 head of cattle water within Lot 1 of Section 19, T.37N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
