CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert N. Caldwell, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Juniper Spring through a spring, spring box, distribution system and stockwatering trough for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10, T.36N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M., (Unsurveyed) or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 6, T.36N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 67° 05' E., 15,729 feet, situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Delong Ranches, Inc.
Source: Juniper Spring
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.0124 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 8, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Juniper Spring into a 24' covered culvert spring box thence conveyed via 100' of 1 1/4" plastic pipe to a 300 gallon Powder River stock trough where 400 head of cattle water within SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of section 10, T.36N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
