WHEREAS, Brien B. Walters, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 16, T.16N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the center ¹/₄ corner of said Section 16, bears S. 35°00'00" W., a distance of 414.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.




