CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Lloyd J. Munson, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Wash O'Neal Creek through a dam, portable pump and sprinkler system for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼ Section 33, T.41N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 33 bears N. 89° 30' W., 360.0 feet distant situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Donald W. and Naida Radbruch
Source: Wash O'Neal Creek
Manner of Use: as decreed
Amount of appropriation: 0.005 c.f.s. but not to exceed 1.8 acre-feet per season, as decreed
Period of use: April 1st to September 27th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: *as decreed

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: 0.5 acres in the NW¼ NW¼ Section 33, T.41N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes a portion of Claim Number 01601 of the Little Humboldt River Decree. Therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 01601.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and further subject to the terms and conditions of the State Engineer's Ruling #3461 dated September 11, 1987.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
