CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert E. Morley, as agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from surface waters through a small earthen dam for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28, T.37N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 28 bears N 39° 41' 00" W, 2420.00 feet, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Charles and Della Van Norman
Source: surface waters
Manner of Use: stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.003 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 21, 1983

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by a small earthen dam less than 10' feet high and impounding less than 10 acre-feet of water where 100 head of cattle water within SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 28, T.37N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
