CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Rodney Harris, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source (Westside Well #2) through a drilled well, windmill and stockwatering troughs for Stockwater and Wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T.39N., R.59E.,
M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE
corner of said Section 36 bears S. 58° 02' 58"
E., a distance of 3622.25 feet situated in
Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U.S.D.I. - Bureau of Land Management
Source: Underground (Westside Well #2)
Manner of Use: Stockwater and Wildlife
Amount of appropriation: 0.016 or sufficient to water 500
head of cattle, 32 antelope and 128
deer
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each
year
Date of priority of
appropriation: October 29, 1981

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from a drilled well, 367 feet deep, 6 inch casing, equipped with a Boujon windmill, thence water is conveyed to a 5,000 gallon storage tank to two 12' x 1.5' stockwatering troughs where 500 cattle, 32 antelope and 128 deer water within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T.39N., R.59E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
