CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (East Highway Well) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T.31N., R.62E.,
M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW
corner of said Section 36 bears S. 31' 34' W.,
a distance of 2,210 feet situated in Elko
County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Loyd Sorensen
Source: Underground (East Highway Well)
Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.016 c.f.s., or sufficient to water
500 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each
year
Date of priority of
appropriation: September 14, 1987

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from a drilled well, 255 feet deep, 6 inch casing, equipped with a Jensen pump jack, 8 h.p. gasoline motor, thence water is conveyed via pipeline to a 5,000 gallon storage tank and then to a 20' stockwatering trough where 500 head of cattle water within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T.31N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
