CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Rodney Harris, as agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dry Fork Reservoir through an earthen dam for stockwater and wildlife purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T.45N., R.60E.,
M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE
corner of said Section 27 bears N. 41° 30' 00"
E., a distance of 3,703.00 feet situated in
Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U.S.D.I.-Bureau of Land Management
and Cottonwood Ranch

Source: Dry Fork Reservoir

Manner of Use: Stockwater and Wildlife

Amount of appropriation: 0.0075 c.f.s. or sufficient to water
230 head of cattle, 25 antelope and
25 deer

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each
year

Date of priority of
appropriation: June 21, 1988


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is consumed at the point of diversion being Dry Fork Reservoir consisting of an earthen dam constructed in an ephemeral channel where 230 cattle, 25 antelope and 25 deer water within NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T.45N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
