CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, M. R. Vandergrift, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well and pump for mining exploration and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 2, T.29S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 2 bears N. 65° 48' 44" E., a distance of 2,428.48 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Snowbird Resources, Ltd.

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Mining Exploration and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.18 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.042 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: April 8, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 299 feet deep, 6 inch casing via a 5 H.P. pump and motor, thence to the place of use for mining exploration and domestic purposes located in portions of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, and SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 2, T.29S., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
