**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

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WHEREAS, Robert R. Squires, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River through the Steamboat Canal, Highland Ditch, Idlewild Treatment Plant and North Truckee Ditch for Municipal and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**Steamboat Canal (Hunter Creek Reservoir):**

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.  
or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 31 bears S. 62° 04' E., a distance of 3,195.0 feet.

**Highland Ditch (Highland Reservoir):**

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.  
or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 9 bears S. 75° 16' E., a distance of 1,650.0 feet.

**Idlewild Treatment Plant:**

SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.  
or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 10 bears S. 69° 57' 58" E., a distance of 842.34 feet.

**North Truckee Ditch (Glendale Treatment Plant):**

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.  
or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 7 bears N. 39° 28' E., a distance of 3,015.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Westpac Utilities
Source:	the Truckee River
Manner of Use:	Municipal and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.0619 c.f.s. but not to exceed 14.4 acre-feet as decreed
Period of use:	as decreed
Date of priority of appropriation:	*as decreed

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is diverted from the Truckee River into Steamboat Canal, Highland Ditch, Idlewild Treatment Plant and North Truckee Ditch, thence the water is treated and pumped into Westpac's water distribution system. The overall system ultimately conveys the treated water to Westpac's water customers within its certified water service area. Said service area is depicted by record (map and legal description) which is filed with the State Engineer's office.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of Permit 16900, Certificate 4545, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Claim #385 of the Truckee River Decree, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim #385.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
