CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Roger Hatch, as Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hatch Spring through a spring, head box and stockwatering tank for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, T.1N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 22 bears S. 61° 30' W., a distance of 4,460.0 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Roger Hatch
Source: Hatch Spring
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.006 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use: March 1st to May 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 20, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from Hatch Spring through a head box and pipeline into a 150 gallon stockwatering tank where 200 head of cattle water within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, T.1N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
