CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kenneth L. Woodward, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, distribution system and stockwatering troughs for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 13, T.32N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 13 bears S. 78° 52' 40" E., a distance of 603.72 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Elko Ranch (1/2 interest) U.S.D.I.-Bureau of Land Management (1/2 interest)
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.003 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 90 head of cattle
Period of use: April 16th to July 16th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 1, 1989

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a drilled well, 322 feet deep, 6 inch casing, equipped with a submersible pump thence water is discharged to a 10,000 gallon steel tank and conveyed via 1 1/2" pipe to two 500 gallon stockwatering troughs (3' high x 15' in diameter) where 90 head of cattle water within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 13, T.32N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M..

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
