CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, the Reverend Thomas F. Hutson, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 15 bears S. 62° 02' 50" W., 1,468.71 feet distant situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The American Baptist Home Mission Society
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Irrigation and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.0379 c.f.s. but not to exceed 2.88 acre-feet annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 4, 1988

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

0.72 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
