CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Roger Eggenburg, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 21, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 21 bears S. 2' 13' 22" E., 1,699.0 feet distant situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Incline Village General Improvement District
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Municipal
Amount of appropriation: 0.078 c.f.s. but not to exceed 0.03 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 13, 1983

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed via a ten-inch well 75 feet in depth equipped with four-inch casing and a submersible pump whence water is conveyed via 1 1/2-inch pipe to a pressure tank and totalizing meter and thence to the place of use through a distribution system where water is used for sanitary, culinary, maintenance and landscaping purposes within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 21, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
