CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert F. Lauder, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ Section 32, T.18N., R.29E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 32 bears N. 4° 17' 39" W., a distance of 4,076.27 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bar Bell Farms, Inc.

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Commercial

Amount of appropriation: 0.16 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.8 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: *June 28, 1982

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 560 feet deep, 6 5/8 inch casing via a 15 H.P. submersible pump and motor, thence through a distribution system to a swine and cattle raising operation, one bunkhouse and one office for commercial purposes located in the N½ and N½ SW¼, a portion of the S½ SW¼ and a portion of the SE¼ all in Section 32, T.18N., R.29E., M.D.B.&M.

The total combined rate of diversion and duty of water under this certificate and Permit 45158, Certificate 11687, is limited to 0.66 c.f.s. and 6.0 million gallons annually.

The total combined duty of water under this certificate and any certificates issued under Permits 48954, 54699 and 54690 shall not exceed 21.9 million gallons annually.


*This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 45879, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 45879.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
