CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, as agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Gamble Farm Stock Well) through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering trough for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ of Section 28, T.40N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 28 bears N. 57° 54' W., a distance of 4,720.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lands of Sierra, Inc.

Source: Underground (Gamble Farm Stock Well)

Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.044 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1400 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: April 28, 1989

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from a drilled well, 100 feet deep, 14 inch casing, equipped with a 2.0 H.P. submersible pump, thence water is conveyed via a short pipeline to a 25' diameter by 22" deep stockwatering trough where 1,400 head of cattle water within the NE¼ of Section 28, T.40N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
