CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, as agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Ferron Carroll Spring through an improved spring for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ of Section 3, T.23¼N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 3, bears S. 49° 38' E., a distance of 2,625.0 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Angelo K. Tsakopoulos

Source: Ferron Carroll Spring

Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.0312 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: June 29, 1981

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from Ferron Carroll Springs through an improved spring channel where 1,000 head of cattle water within the NW¼ SE¼ of Section 3, T.23¼N., R.49E., M.D.B.&M.

The amount of water used for domestic purposes out of Ferron Carroll Springs is 4,500 gallons per year.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
