CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Michael D. Buschelman, as agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, distribution system and stockwatering troughs for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ of Section 20, T.35N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 20 bears N. 83° 20' 04" W., a distance of 3,141.95 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Priscilla Layton Family Partnership

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.02 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 600 head of cattle and 75 horses

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 16, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from a drilled well, 168 feet deep, 6 inch casing, thence water is conveyed via pipeline to one 2,000 gallon stockwatering trough and four 500 gallon troughs where 600 head of cattle and 75 horses water within the NW¼ NE¼ of Section 20, T.35N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
