CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, B.J. Vasey, as agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well and stockwatering pond for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ of Section 7, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 7 bears S. 59° 18' W., a distance of 3,055.0 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Chris and Betty Cordes

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.008 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 250 cattle, 20 sheep and 6 horses

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: November 23, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from a drilled well of unknown depth equipped with 3" casing where it naturally flows into a pond where 250 cattle, 20 sheep and 6 horses water within the NW¼ SE¼ of Section 7, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
