CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James W. Elliot, as agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Early's Spring No. 2 through an improved spring and cement catchment pond for stockwater, wildlife and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Lot 2 of Section 6, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/16 corner of Sections 5 and 6, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 53° 52' 32" E., a distance of 1,582.4 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U.S.D.I. - Bureau of Land Management

Source: Early's Spring No. 2

Manner of Use: Stockwater, Wildlife and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: \*0.005 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 149 cattle and 25 deer

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 25, 1989

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted at Early's Spring No. 2 into a cement catchment pond 3' x 3' x 2' deep where 149 cattle and 25 deer water within Lot 2 of Section 6, T.20N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

\*The amount used for domestic purposes out of Early's Spring No. 2 is 5,000 gallons per year for use at 5 or 6 cow camps.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
