CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Bruce R. Scott, as agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Turquoise Well Site) through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering trough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SE¼ Section 16, T.5N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 4, T.5N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 6° 43' E., a distance of 15,451.0 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Store Safe Redlands Associates, Ltd., dba Rock Springs Ranch
Source: Underground (Turquoise Well Site)
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 2, 1991

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from a drilled well, 180 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump and motor. Water is stored in a 10,000 gallon storage tank, thence it is piped to an underground float chamber and into a 1,000 gallon watering trough where 500 head of cattle water within the SW¼ SE¼ Section 16, T.5N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
