CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Gilman Spring No. 1 through the natural spring source and troughs for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SE¼ Section 5, T.28N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed) or at a point from which the N¼ corner of Section 2, T.28N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 72° 22' 29" W., a distance of 17,920.62 feet situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Joe Saval Company

Source: Gilman Spring No.1

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.0067 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 360 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: January 3, 1991

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from a natural spring site with man made improvements. Improvements consist of pipeline from natural spring site to an 8-foot long by 2½-foot wide stockwatering trough, where 360 head of cattle water within the SE¼ SE¼ Section 5, T.28N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M. (unsurveyed).

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
