CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Maxine Woolman has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SE¼ Section 5, T.17N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 5 bears S. 57° 40' 15" E., a distance of 2,130.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Mark Anderson
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.026 c.f.s, but not to exceed 0.66 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: *November 30, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 125 feet deep, 6 5/8" casing, equipped with a submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to one (1) house, located within a portion of the S¼ SE¼ Section 5, T.17N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., for domestic purposes.

*The date of priority was established in accordance with NRS 533.395(3) by the cancellation rescission hearing of January 6, 1989.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
