CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Robert R. Squires, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (21st Street Well) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SE¼ Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¼ corner of said Section 7 bears N. 21° 41' 00" E., a distance of 945.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: City of Sparks (Owner)
Westpac Utilities (Distributor)

Source: Underground (21st Street Well)

Manner of Use: Municipal and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.184 c.f.s., but not to exceed 6.517 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: *May 16, 1968

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 248 feet deep, 16 inch casing, via a Peabody Floway 5 stage pump with a 200 H.P. G.E. motor, thence through Westpac's utilities water distribution system for municipal purposes located as described in the legal description and shown on the supporting map on file in the office of the State Engineer, Division of Water Resources, State of Nevada.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of Permit 24493, Certificate 8058, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 24493, Certificate 8058.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and is further subject to the terms and conditions of the Groundwater Management Agreement between Westpac Utilities and Truckee-Carson Irrigation District dated September 5, 1991.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
