CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, John E. Nay, as Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an improved spring through diversion to a reservoir for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 30, T.12N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M.  
or at a point from which U.S. Monument No. 272  
bears N. 89° 10' W., a distance of 28,265.0  
feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Nay Land and Livestock Co.  
Source: Seven Mile Spring  
Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic  
Amount of appropriation: 0.1 c.f.s. or sufficient to water  
2,500 head of sheep, 50 head of  
cattle and 50 horses  
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each  
year  
Date of priority of  
appropriation: August 12, 1928

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the natural spring site through V-shaped trenches that collect and convey it 700 feet, to a reservoir created by an earthen dam where 2,500 head of sheep, 50 head of cattle and 50 horses water within the NE¼ NE¼ Section 30, T.12N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
