CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Griswold-Parker Spring through a diversion for Stockwater & Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ Section 14, T.31N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 14, bears N. 40° 54' E., a distance of 3,428.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Loyd Sorensen

Source: Griswold-Parker Spring

Manner of Use: *Stockwater & Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 600 head of cattle & 5,000 head of sheep

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: June 29, 1981

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is collected by a perforated 50-gallon steel drum, buried in the spring source, thence conveyed 200-feet via 1½-inch plastic pipeline to a 650-gallon trough where 600 head of cattle & 5,000 head of sheep water within the SW¼ NE¼ and NW¼ SE¼ Section 14, T.31N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M..

*The amount of water used for domestic purposes from Griswold-Parker Spring is 2,250 gallons per year.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
