CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Spring Pond No. 1 through a diversion for Stockwater & Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ Section 29, T.33N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 32, T.33N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 11° 35' E., a distance of 6,864 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: **Loyd Sorensen**

Source: **Spring Pond No. 1**

Manner of Use: ***Stockwater & Domestic**

Amount of appropriation: **0.05 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 600 head of cattle & 5,000 head of sheep**

Period of use: **January 1st to December 31st of each year**

Date of priority of appropriation: **June 29, 1981**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water from the improved spring is impounded within a naturally occurring pond where 600 head of cattle & 5,000 head of sheep water within the NW¼ SE¼ Section 29, T.33N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M..

*The amount of water used for domestic purposes from Spring Pond No. 1 is 2,250 gallons per year.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
