CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hall Ranch Spring through a diversion to troughs for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ Section 17, T.28N., R.51E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 17 bears N. 13° 20' W., a distance of 1,490.0 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Leo Damele and Sons Ranches, Inc.
Source: Hall Ranch Spring
Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: *0.0094 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 12, 1987

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from an improved spring through a spring box to two 800-gallon troughs where 300 head of cattle water within the E¼ NW¼ Section 21, SE¼ NW¼ and SW¼ NE¼ Section 15, T.28N., R.51E., M.D.B.&M.

*The amount of water used for domestic purposes out of Hall Ranch Spring is 15,000 gallons per year.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
