CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Richard W. Forman, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unimproved spring through a diversion to a holding pond for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ Section 21, T.11N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.
or at a point from which the NW corner of said
Section 21 bears N. 05° 22' 00" W., a distance
of 1,747.0 feet situated in White Pine County,
State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:


Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the natural spring site and impounded in a 500 feet by 100 feet holding pond created by an earthen dam, thence piped to a lower field where 8 horses water within the SE¼ NE¼ Section 20 and SW¼ NW¼ Section 21, all in T.11N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
