CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, LeGrand Timothy Terry, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from King's Canyon Creek through a diversionary structure, to a holding pond for fire protection purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 23, T.15N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.,
or at a point from which the NE corner of said
Section 23, bears N. 43° 53' 16" E., a
distance of 1,790.0 feet situated in Carson
City, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: LeGrand Timothy Terry and Laurel M. Terry
Source: King's Canyon Creek
Manner of Use: Fire Protection
Amount of appropriation: *0.25 acre-feet per year for evaporative losses
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: **As Decreed

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from King's Canyon Creek by a small rock dam via a 3 inch metal pipeline to an earthen holding pond, under Permit 46019, Certificate 12890, thence through a 4 inch plastic pipeline to the Terry holding pond, plastic lined, earthen and measures 65 feet by 40 feet, where it is held for fire protection purposes. A 4 inch plastic pipe returns overflow water from the Terry holding pond to King's Canyon Creek within the SE¼ NE¼ Section 23, T.15N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 23 bears N. 33° 44' 25" E., a distance of 1,645.0 feet.

*No consumptive use is allowed under normal conditions, except for 0.25 acre-feet per year due to evaporation and other losses.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of King's Canyon Creek as heretofore granted under the Civil Decree of the District Court of the Second Judicial District of Nevada dated November 14, 1885, pertaining to King's Canyon Creek, Gregory Canyon Creek and Ash Canyon Creek, therefore the date of priority remains the same as King's Canyon Creek Civil Decree.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and further subject to the terms of said King's Canyon Creek Civil Decree.

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The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
