CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an improved spring through a diversion for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ Section 34, T.46N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.  
or at a point from which the SW corner of said  
Section 34, bears S. 16° 30' W., a distance of  
3,250.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of  
Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Salmon River Cattlemen's Association, Inc.  
Source: Mahogany Rim Spring  
Manner of Use: Stockwater  
Amount of appropriation: \*0.011 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 350 head of cattle  
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation: June 15, 1990

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is collected by perforated plastic pipe buried within a spring source, thence conveyed 200 feet via plastic pipeline to a trough with overflow into a natural channel where 350 head of cattle water within the SW¼ NW¼ Section 34, T.46N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M..

\*The issuance of this certificate hereby corrects the amount of appropriation under Permit 54959 to 0.01 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 350 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
