CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William Joseph Richter, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ SW¼ Section 19, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 19 bears S. 56° 08' 19" W., a distance of 2,220.16 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: William Joseph Richter

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Irrigation

Amount of appropriation: 0.045 c.f.s., but not to exceed 12.6 acre-feet annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: *September 9, 1975

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:


1.54 acres in the NE¼ SW¼ Section 19, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
1.61 acres in the SE¼ SW¼ Section 19, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
3.15 Acres Total

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 37953, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 29637, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 29637.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
