CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Jim Andme, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from surface water runoff that is impounded in an earthen reservoir for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SE¼ of Section 21, T.45N., R.47E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 18, T.46N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 66° 36' 09" E., a distance of 85,360.88 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Snake River Cattle Trucking Co., Inc.
Source: Surface Water Runoff
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.01 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 19, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is impounded in a 75 feet by 75 feet by 4 feet deep earthen reservoir where 300 head of cattle water within the NW¼ SE¼ of Section 21, T.45N., R.47E., M.D.B.&M..

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
