CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Byron L. Wilkerson, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through a springbox and distribution system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NW¼ Section 20, T.39N., R.46E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 20 bears S. 45° 06' 40" E., a distance of 5,696.75 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Byron L. Wilkerson

Source: An Unnamed Spring

Manner of Use: Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.0045 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.05 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: December 2, 1982

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from an improved spring by means of intake piping and a springbox thence water is conveyed via 5,000 feet of 1½" pipeline to a 1,000 gallon storage tank thence through 500 feet of 1¼" pipeline to the permittee's residence within the SE¼ SE¼ Section 20, T.39N., R.46E., M.D.B.&M., being Lots 13 and 14, Block 6 of the Moffat Addition to the Gold Circle Townsite (Midas), where it is used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
