CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, John H. Milton, III, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through a developed spring, pump and distribution system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ SW¼ Section 1, T.35N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¼ corner of said Section 1 bears N. 44° 28' W., a distance of 1,722.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: John L. McAnallan and Bea Rae McAnallan

Source: An Unnamed Spring

Manner of Use: Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.033 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.657 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: March 27, 1985

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from a 4 foot diameter by 16 foot long perforated culvert in a 15 foot by 20 foot rockd spring. Water is pumped via a 3/4 H.P submersible pump through a distribution system to one single family trailer space with landscaping for domestic purposes located within the NW¼ SW¼ of Section 1, T.35N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
