CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, James W. Elliott, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Paiute Spring through a diversion for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ Section 21, T.24N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E¼ corner of Section 20, T.24N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 87° 30' W., a distance of 908.60 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U.S.D.I. Bureau of Land Management & Robert Marshall (dba Intermountain Land and Cattle Co.)

Source: Paiute Spring

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.0022 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 418 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: February 16, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted through a 36 inch metal spring box buried in gravel through 1¼ inch plastic pipeline to two 450 gallon troughs and a 10' by 10' by 3' deep overflow pond where 418 head of cattle and various wildlife water within the SW¼ NW¼ and the NW¼ SW¼ of Section 21, T.24N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
