CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Tex Hazelwood Spring through a diversion for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ Section 35, T.46N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the S¼ corner of said Section 35, bears S. 70° 18' E., a distance of 1,932.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Salmon River Cattlemen's Association, Inc.

Source: Tex Hazelwood Spring

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.0156 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: June 15, 1990

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring by means of a wooden spring box and perforated plastic pipe, thence piped 20 feet to two steel stockwater troughs where 500 head of cattle and various wildlife water within the SW¼ SW¼ Section 35, T.46N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M..

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
