CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an improved spring through a diversion for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 8, T.45N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 8, bears N. 77° 07' E., a distance of 1,526.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Salmon River Cattlemen's Association, Inc.

Source: Upper Scott Creek Spring

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.0094 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: June 15, 1990

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an improved spring through 150 feet of plastic pipeline to six 200 gallon stockwater troughs, where 300 head of cattle and various wildlife water within the NW¼ NE¼ Section 8, T.45N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M..

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
