CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an improved spring to a small earthen reservoir for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 29, T.29N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of Section 36, T.29N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 65° 55' E., a distance of 25,230.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Von L. and Marian Sorensen
Source: Upper North Creek Spring
Manner of Use: Stockwater & Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.0093 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 27, 1991

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is impounded in a small earthen reservoir immediately below a spring, where 300 head of cattle and various wildlife water within the SW¼ SE¼, SE¼ SE¼ of Section 20, and the NW¼ NE¼ of Section 29, T.29N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M..

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and further subject to the State Engineer's Ruling No. 3954 dated April 7, 1993.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
