CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, William A. Card, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and generator for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ of Section 35, T.11N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 35 bears N. 56° 28' 53" E., a distance of 2,307.56 feet situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: William A. Card
Source: Underground
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.0071 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 23, 1990

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 310 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing, equipped with a submersible pump and generator, to a 10,000 gallon storage tank, thence to a point where 300 head of cattle water within the NW¼ NE¼ of Section 35, T.11N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M., being within the Gillis Mountain Allotment.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
