CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James W. Elliott, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lucky Spring through a diversion to a small reservoir for stockwater and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SE¼ Section 10, T.22N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¼ corner of said Section 10 bears N. 32° 15' 50" E., a distance of 466.0 feet situated in Washoe County Nevada, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lucky Hereford Ranch and BLM (U.S. Department of Interior)
Source: Lucky Spring
Manner of Use: Stockwater and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.0062 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use: April 15th to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 19, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the fenced spring site and impounded in a 30 feet by 30 feet by 1½ feet deep reservoir where 200 head of cattle and various wildlife water within the S¼ NW¼ and N¼ SW¼ Section 11, T.22N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
