CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Kenneth L. Haskew, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (North Adit) through a mine tunnel for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

within the NE¼ NE¼ of Section 30, T.30N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 31, T.30N., R.23½E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 59° 55' 02" W., a distance of 15,126.3 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Limbo Mines
Source: Underground (North Adit)
Manner of Use: Mining, Milling and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.016 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.55 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: *October 6, 1988

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a mine adit, thence the water is conveyed via 300 feet of 1½ inch polyethylene pipeline to three storage ponds for mining, milling and domestic (two trailers) purposes all located within the SW¼ Section 21 and the E¼ SE¼ Section 20, T.30N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 26988, Certificate 9458. The priority date as set by the terms of the permit is October 6, 1988.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
