CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, F. M. Fulstone, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through a sump, pipeline and concrete trough for mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SW¼ Section 31, T.14N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¼ corner of said Section 31 bears N. 64° 38' W., a distance of 2,153.0 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: F. M. Fulstone, Inc.
Source: An Unnamed Spring
Manner of Use: Mining and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s.
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 18, 1931

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from an unnamed spring where a 20 feet by 20 feet by 12 feet sump was constructed, thence through a 4 inch pipe to a concrete trough from which barrels and tanks are filled and transported to the NE¼ SW¼ and the SW¼ SW¼ of Section 31, T.14N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M. for mining and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
