CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Millard G. Reed, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground well through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for industrial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ Section 14, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 14 bears N. 84° 41' 28" E., a distance of 2,306.63 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: **Cities of Reno and Sparks Wastewater Treatment Plant**

Source: **Underground**

Manner of Use: **Industrial**

Amount of appropriation: **0.006 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.916 million gallons annually**

Period of use: **January 1st to December 31st of each year**

Date of priority of appropriation: **October 22, 1985**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 100 feet deep, 10 inch casing via a pump, thence through a distribution system to the Reno and Sparks Wastewater Treatment Plant for industrial purposes located within the NW¼ NE¼ Section 14, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
