CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Gary Ryan, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from surface water run-off through a pit reservoir for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SE¼ NE¼ Section 1, T.6S., R.70E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE¼ corner of Section 36, T.5S., R.70E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 4° 32' W., a distance of 2,014.4 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U.S.D.I. Bureau of Land Management
Source: Surface Water Run-off
Manner of Use: Stockwater
Amount of appropriation: 0.00625 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle
Period of use: May 15th to November 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: *October 4, 1993

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Surface water run-off is impounded in a 100 feet by 40 feet by 13 feet deep pit reservoir, where 200 head of cattle water within the SE¼ NE¼ Section 1, T.6S., R.70E., M.D.B.&M.

*The date of priority was established in accordance with NRS 533.395(3) by the cancellation rescission hearing of May 3, 1994.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
