CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Jay Rooker, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ Section 28, T.19N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE¼ corner of said Section 28 bears N. 07° 21' 03" W., a distance of 2,331.75 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Jay Rooker and Louise Rooker

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal

Amount of appropriation: 0.025 c.f.s., but not to exceed 3.723 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: April 11, 1989

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 225 feet deep, 8 inch casing, via a 2 H.P. submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to the OK Mobile Home Park with 34 hookups for quasi-municipal purposes located within the SW¼ NE¼ of Section 28, T.19N., R.28E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
