CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Kenneth J. Gavan, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, motor and distribution system for commercial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ of Section 15, T.19N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¼ corner of said Section 15 bears S. 51° 02' 37" W., a distance of 825.15 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: N. A. Degerstrom, Inc.

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Commercial and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.015 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: September 12, 1990

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 123 feet deep, 6 inch diameter casing and a 3/4 horsepower pump, thence through a distribution system to a watchman's office trailer, located within the W½ SW¼ NW¼ of Section 15, T.19N., R.27E., M.D.B.&M. for commercial and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
