CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Gilbert O. Roth, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ Section 6, T.21S., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 6 bears S. 10° 15' 39" W., a distance of 1,195.78 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: V.F.W. Post 10054 Clyde E. Newman Post

Source: Underground

Manner of Use: Commercial and Domestic

Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.365 million gallons annually

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: \*May 27, 1981

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 8 inch casing via a submersible pump, thence through a distribution system to V.F.W. Post 10054 with canteen, kitchen and landscaping located within a portion of the W¼ SW¼ Section 6, T.21S., R.54E., M.D.B.&M.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 43791, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 43791.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
