CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Rodney Harris, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cherry Creek Reservoir through a small earthen dam for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SE¼ Section 5, T.26N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 5 bears N. 61° 20' 00" W., a distance of 10,420.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: U.S.D.I. - Bureau of Land Management and Bertrand Paris & Sons

Source: Cherry Creek Reservoir

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.01 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 1,500 head of sheep, 10 horses and 50 deer

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: April 18, 1991

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is impounded behind a small earthen dam that is 9 feet high, 12 feet crest width and 100 feet crest length with an unconfined spillway that is 12 feet wide and 3 feet deep from which 1,500 head of sheep, 10 horses and 50 deer water within the SW¼ SE¼ and SE¼ SE¼ Section 5, T.26N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
