CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Larry R. Miller, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Reaper (surface) through graded field, drain and stockwatering troughs for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 12, T.15N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 12 bears N. 57° E., a distance of 82.0 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Larry R. Miller

Source: Reaper (surface)

Manner of Use: Stockwater

Amount of appropriation: 0.002 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 60 head of cattle

Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: July 27, 1984

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Rain water is collected from a graded field 175' X 175', thence the water flows through a drain to an underground 10,000 gallon storage tank to 3 stockwater troughs via a float valve system where 60 head of cattle water within the NE¼ NE¼ Section 12, T.15N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
